# Daily Devotionals

## Monday read Luke 2:8-20

- What does this passage say about Jesus? Who is He and why did He come?
- Ever make an entrance? What does Jesus' chosen place of birth say about Him? How does even this fact make Him a Savior to believe ON?
- When was the last time you felt like the shepherds in verse 16-20? What can you do to create that kind of personal excitement?

## Tuesday read Galatians 4:1-7

- What does this passage say about Jesus? Who is He and why did He come?
- We know Jesus is the Son of God, but how does it make you feel to be adopted as full heirs as seen in Verse 5?
- Reread verse 7. What responsibilities go with being a part of this family? What privileges?

## Wednesday read Micah 5:1-5

- What does this passage say about Jesus? Who is He and why did He come?
- The end of verse 2 shows how Jesus is different from all other rulers. What's the difference and why is it significant?
- Reread verse 4-5. Pray through each line of this verse asking God to make each part real for you and your life.

## Thursday read John 1:1-14

- What does this passage say about Jesus? Who is He and why did He come?
- Reread this passage aloud (if you can without looking too goofy) but replace 'WORD' with 'JESUS' each time it appears.
- Is Jesus dwelling with you? If He actually lived with you, when and where would you be most uncomfortable?

## Read Hebrews 2:14-18

- What does this passage say about Jesus? Who is He and why did He come?
- Verse 17 says He became like us to be merciful on our behalf. Where are you most glad Jesus knows what it's like to be a human being?
- Start memorizing verse 18.
