

### Monday—Read Ephesians Chapter 1

- Focus on Verse 11—If God chose you, what should that mean about your view of yourself?
- Focus on Verse 12— What are you planning on doing today that will bring God glory?
- Focus on Verse 18 & 19— Pray for each of these things to become real in your life, and in our church's life.

### Tuesday—Read Ephesians Chapter 2

- Focus on Verse 8, 9 & 10—Why are we given God's grace? What good works are you a part of in the church?
- Focus on Verse 19 & 20—What does membership in a group like this mean to you? What should it mean to others around you?
- Focus on Verse 21—What can you do today to make your life a more suitable dwelling for God to live?

### Wednesday—Read Ephesians Chapter 3

- Focus on Verse 17 & 18— Is there an area of your life where it seems the love of Christ has a hard time reaching? What's the issue (hint: the problem is on your end)?
- Focus on Verse 20 & 21—What is the God-Sized need in your life today? How can you turn this over to "His power that is at work within us"?
- Pray through verses 14-19 once for your life, once for the life of someone in your family, and once for the life of someone in our church.

### Thursday—Read Ephesians Chapter 4

- Focus on Verse 11 & 12—What works of service is God preparing you for to build up the body of Christ (the church)?
- Focus on Verse 11, 12 & 13—How full of Christ are you (0-100%)? According to this passage, maturity comes through service. What service can you do that will stretch you into maturity?

### Friday—Read Ephesians Chapter 5

- Focus on Verse 1—What parts of your life obviously fall short of this command?
- Focus on Verse 3 & 4— A hint is a very small amount. Are there steps you need to take to fix this in your life?
- Focus on Verse 21—Pray through and plan a random act of submission today.

### Saturday—Read Ephesians Chapter 6

- Focus on Verse 10-18—Pray through each of these pieces of clothing/armor and imagine putting them on as you prepare for what lies ahead.
